## Announcing a special scholarship for new international freshmen

# International Undergraduate Scholarship

The Ohio State University is committed to enrolling a diverse and talented student population. The International Undergraduate Scholarship is offered to qualified full-time, Columbus campus international freshmen (students who have not attended university since graduating from high school/secondary school) who are required to pay the nonresident tuition surcharge.

### Eligibility

The International Undergraduate Scholarship is awarded on a competitive basis to admitted international freshmen with ACT composite scores of 27 or higher or combined SAT Critical Reading and Math scores of 1220 or higher.

### Award

\$6,600 (\$26,400 four-year value)

This award is renewable annually for a maximum of 12 quarters (or the equivalent) of full-time undergraduate enrollment, provided the recipient continues to pay the nonresident tuition surcharge, maintains a 2.5 or higher grade point average (earned by no later than the end of the second year), and makes satisfactory academic progress.

### To be considered

Students must submit the application for admission and all supporting materials by the application deadline to be considered for this award.
